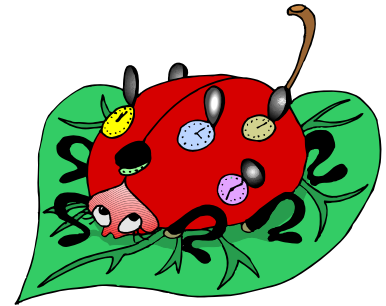


# The Grouchy Ladybug Timeline

In the story, the grouchy ladybug met insects, animals, and sea creatures at specific times during the day. Time can be shown in many different ways. A timeline is one way to show in what order events happen in a story.



Below is one example of a timeline. Look at the timeline carefully to see the creatures that the grouchy ladybug met and then answer the questions that follow.

5:00 am – Landed on a leaf	2:00 pm – Gorilla
6:00 am – Yellow jacket	3:00 pm – Rhinoceros
7:00 am - Stag beetle	4:00 pm – Elephant
8:00 am – Praying mantis	5:00 pm – Whale
9:00 am - Sparrow	5:15 pm – Whale’s flipper
10:00 am – Lobster	5:30 pm – Whale’s fin
11:00 am – Skunk	5:45 pm – Whale’s tail
12:00 pm –Boa constrictor	6:00 pm – Arrived back on the leaf
1:00 pm - Hyena
