

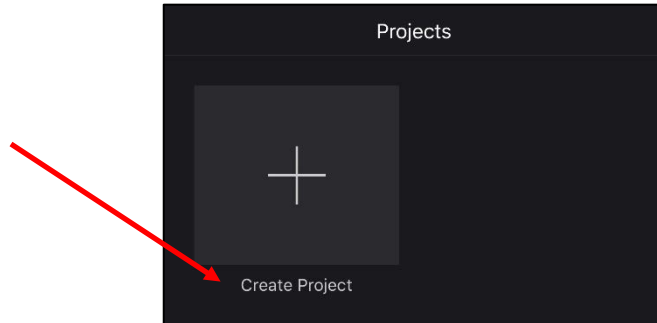


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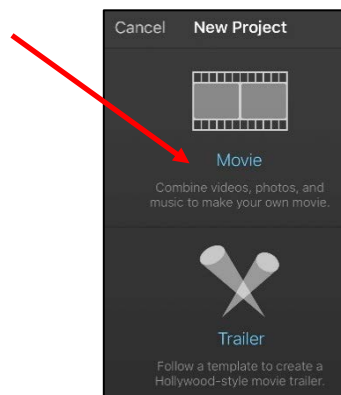
Taking and Editing Video

As stated earlier, the easiest way to record video is likely just from an iPhone or smart phone. You can use a video camera but that type of equipment may be harder to get your hands on and there are few inexpensive, easy-to-use video editing software options available. So, we suggest taking the video using an iPhone and then using iMovie for editing. Follow the simple instructions below.

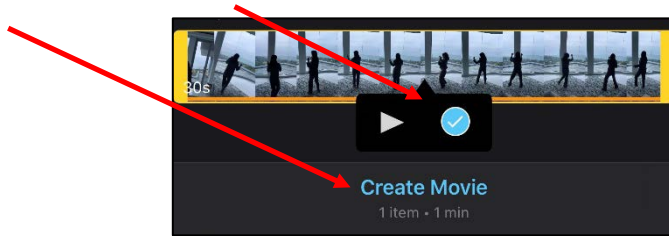
1. Download **iMovie** onto your phone.
2. Tap **Create Project**.



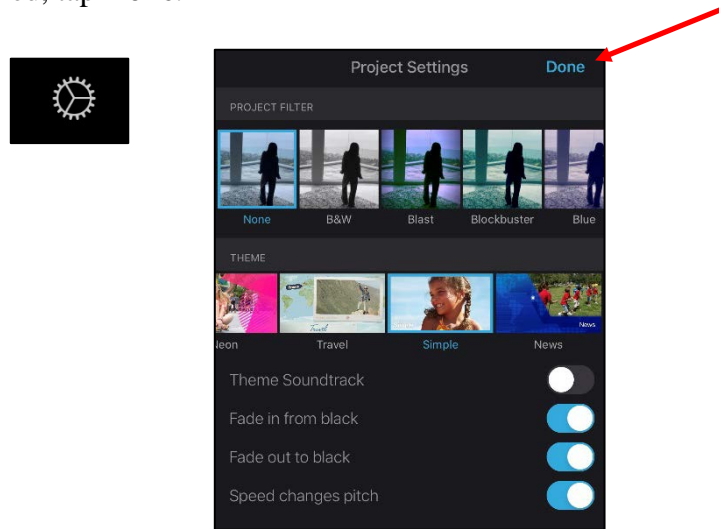
3. Tap **Movie**.



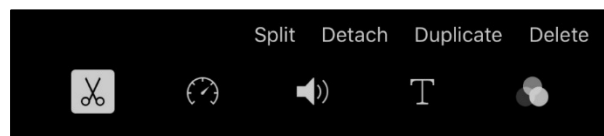
4. Select the media you wish to turn into a movie and then tap **Create Movie**. For this example, select the video you recorded. Then tap the **checkmark** and then click **Create Movie**.



5. Tap the **gear** icon in the bottom right corner and then choose your project settings. When you are finished, tap **Done**.



6. To edit the video, tap on the actual video footage. A yellow box appears around the video and options for editing appear.



Tap the **scissor** icon to pinch in to make the video shorter or pinch out to make the video longer.

Tap the **speedometer** to add slow motion or speed up the video.

Tap the **speaker** to change the volume of the audio on the video.

Tap the **T** to add title text to the video. You will likely want to tap the beginning of the video and then tap the **T** to add the title. There are many options to choose from for the

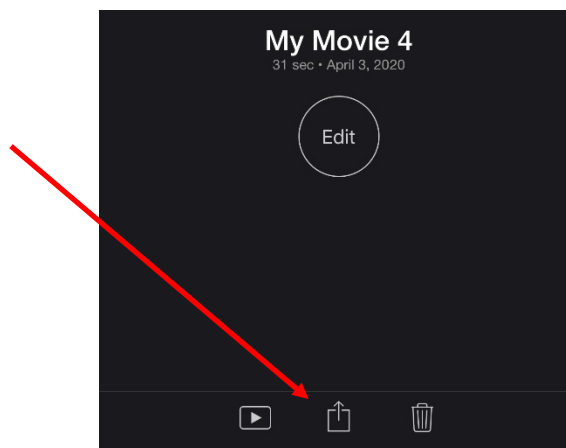
style of the title. To add the title, simply tap on **Title Text Here** and use the keypad to type.

The **color** icon allows you to change the saturation of the colors in the video.

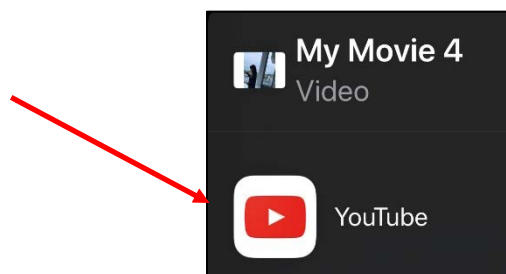
7. At any time you can tap the **question mark** icon in the top right corner for help. When you are finished editing the video, tap **Done**.



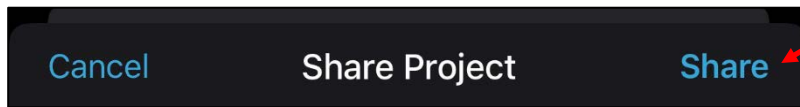
8. Now you can either edit the movie, play the movie, upload the movie, or delete it. Tap **upload** to add the movie to your YouTube channel.



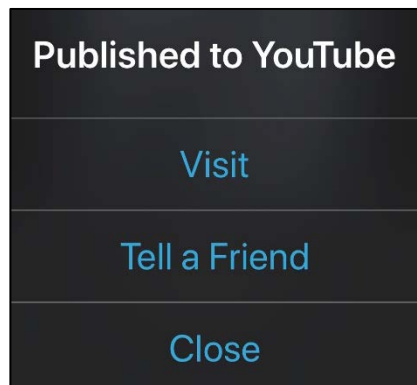
9. Scroll through the options until you see YouTube. Tap **YouTube**. You are prompted to sign into your Google account. Allow iMovie to access your Google account by tapping **Allow**.



10. Tap the **Share** button. Your movie begins exporting and uploading to the YouTube channel connected to your Google account.



11. When the process is complete, you will see the following on the screen. Tap **Visit** to watch the video on your YouTube channel. Tap **Tell a Friend** to send an e-mail link to students, post it to your Google Classroom, post it on social media, text the link, or simply save to a file.



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
